All prospective international students are required by the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) to provide documented evidence of financial resources for their first full academic year (9 months / 2 semesters) prior to GCC issuing the Form I-20 (application for F-1 student status). At Genesee Community College, the required amount for the first full academic year is **\$14,310 in U.S. funds for the 2009-2010 academic year**. This amount is based on the college's estimate of tuition and fees, housing, books and supplies, medical insurance, and miscellaneous living expenses.

Tuition, fees, and medical insurance are paid to the college at the time of registration each semester. For instance, approximately **\$2,300** is due upon registration for the Fall term in August, and another payment is due upon registration for the Spring term in January. The cost of housing is based upon living in a double room apartment at College Village. College Village requires payment of a **\$100** application fee, a **\$250** security deposit, and a per semester housing payment of **\$2650** for a double apartment suite.
