Specific Nursing Requirements

- NUR110 prerequisite: Admission to the Nursing Program.
prerequisite: or concurrent: BIO 105 with a grade of “C” or higher
co-requisites: BIO 122 and NUR CL1
- NUR120 prerequisites: NUR110, BIO105, and BIO122 with a grade of “C” or higher.
prerequisite or co-requisite: BIO106 with a grade of “C” or higher
co-requisite: NUR CL2
- NUR210 prerequisites: NUR120 and BIO106 with a grade of “C” or higher.
prerequisites or concurrent: BIO 201 with a grade of “C” or higher
co-requisites: PSY203, NUR215, and NUR CL3
- NUR220 prerequisites: BIO 201, NUR 210, NUR 215, and PSY 203 with a grade of “C” or higher
co-requisites: NUR225, NUR CL4, NUR250, and NUR CL5
- NUR250 prerequisites: BIO 201, NUR210, NUR215, and PSY 203 with a grade of “C” or higher
co-requisites: NUR220, NUR CL4, NUR225, and NUR CL5
- NUR215 prerequisite: NUR120 with a grade of “C” or higher.
co-requisite: NUR210
- NUR225 prerequisites: NUR210 and NUR215 with a grade of “C” or higher
co-requisites: NUR220 and NUR250
- **Nursing students must achieve a minimum grade of “C” in all sciences–BIO105, BIO106 and BIO201 to progress in the program.**

The oral component of the SUNY General Education Basic Communication requirement is infused in the curriculum through the following courses: NUR110, NUR120, NUR210.

***NOTE:** Students planning to transfer should carefully review their program with an academic advisor to ensure that course sequences meet the requirements of the institution to which they expect to transfer.*

General Curriculum Information

English (by placement): Satisfactory completion of the writing skills exam is a prerequisite for ENG101. Students who do not satisfactorily complete the writing exam must register for ENG091 and/or ENG100 prior to completing their six (6) hour English sequence.

Mathematics (by placement): Mathematics placement is based on the ACT, ASSET, or COMPASS placement test.

Reading Proficiency Requirement: All students will be required to demonstrate proficiency in reading through testing prior to earning a degree or certificate. Students who do not meet the required standard will be expected to begin remediation immediately.
