WHEREAS, Congress has enacted the Crime Awareness and Campus Security Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Genesee Community College intends to comply with the requirements of that Act,

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Trustees adopts the following policy:

- A. Genesee Community College's Public Safety Office shall cooperate with the Vice President for Student Services and the Personal Safety/Campus Security Advisory Committee to inform students and employees about campus security measures to encourage all persons to be concerned about a secure campus environment and to be aware of security concerns on campus.
 - 1. Public Safety shall develop programs and distribute appropriate materials about campus security procedures to students and employees. Security presentations will be conducted at appropriate times, including orientation visits.
 - 2. Public Safety, the Health Office, and the Vice President for Student Services will develop appropriate publications about security topics, programs, procedures and personnel.

- B. Students and employees shall be educated as to their personal responsibility for security and for the security of others.
 - 1. Education shall be through appropriate programs and educational booklets.
 - 2. The campus community will also be informed about security matters via

campus media.
