**TITLE: POLICY ON SECURITY AND ACCESS TO CAMPUS
FACILITIES AND SECURITY CONSIDERATION IN
MAINTAINING CAMPUS FACILITIES**

WHEREAS, Congress has enacted the Crime Awareness and Campus Security Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Genesee Community College intends to comply with the requirements of that Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees seeks to provide an atmosphere of openness for the encouragement of collegiate activity on campus facilities;

WHEREAS, the policy of promoting openness must be balanced by controls on access to campus facilities designed to promote security in campus facilities,

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Trustees adopts the following policy:

- A. Public Safety will develop rules and regulations on access and security of campus facilities including parking, vehicle registration and sign-in procedures.
- B. Public Safety shall inspect the lighting, landscaping and the College's physical plant (door, locks, etc.) to determine what improvements, if any, need to be made for security on the campus.
- C. Public Safety will examine or cause to have examined all campus facilities to determine if any security concerns exist in those facilities.

D. Definitions

1. "Campus" is defined as any building or property owned or controlled by the College within a reasonably contiguous geographic area and used by the College in direct support of or related to its educational purposes, or any building or property owned or controlled by student organizations recognized by the College.
2. "Campus" shall also include County Campus Centers operated by the College in Warsaw, Albion, Arcade and Lakeville, and any other campus center established after the adoption of this policy.
