Library Technology

The library has PCs available with Microsoft Office and four study rooms with PCs. There is also a Media Room with DVD/VCR units and the entire library has wireless access.

Library Cards & Loan Periods

Full time faculty may check out books for 6 months; part-time faculty until the end of the semester. CDs circulate for 21 days to all borrowers. Your Genesee ID card is also your library card and can be obtained at the Student Union on the Batavia campus or through your campus center office.

Materials from Other Libraries

Books or copies of articles may also be obtained from other libraries through a process called interlibrary loan. Students may place five of these requests per course, per semester. Place your request via **ILLiad**, the online Interlibrary Loan Request system. ILLiad is available via the library's web page or directly at <http://genesee.illiad.oclc.org/illiad/logon.html>. This process can take 1-3 weeks for books and less than one week for article copies.

Library Instruction & Information Literacy

Learning to find, evaluate and use information resources is an important part of a college education. English classes (ENG 101 & 102) receive one session per semester of information literacy instruction. Instruction for many other courses/subject areas (such as HIS, PSY, SOC, CRJ, FYE, EDF, POS & Allied Health) is also regularly given, and can be arranged by calling the Reference Desk at Ext. 6419, Nicki Lerczak at Ext. 6418 or through our online form at <http://www.genesee.edu/library/Form/InstructionRequest.cfm>. We request at least 2 weeks' advance notice when scheduling.

Assistance infusing information literacy concepts and/or incorporating library resources into research assignments is always available.

Reserve Service

GCC library (or your own) materials may be placed on reserve at the library. Reserve services are operated in compliance with United States Copyright Law. Guidelines for placement of materials and a sample letter for requesting copyright permission are available. Please call the Circulation Desk at Ext. 6350 to make arrangements.
