IMPORTANT INFO ABOUT WITHDRAWING FROM COURSES

- Course registration creates a financial obligation. Withdrawing from courses removes the ACE Scholarship from your account. You will, then, be responsible for the full, undiscounted tuition and associated fees.
- Please think carefully **before** you register for a course. There is no such thing as “*trying out*” a college course. Once you register, you are financially obligated. Students are still responsible for payment for courses despite withdrawal, unless it is prior to the **start of the semester**.
- Please be sure you understand the semester start date, drop/add period, and withdrawal deadlines for *each* course prior to registration. Once you are registered, you are financially obligated.
- Non-attendance is not a withdrawal. Non-attendance in registered courses will result in a final grade of **F**.
