What will happen after I apply?

Good question. But first, take a minute to make sure that you've filled out everything that you need to on the application form.

- Most importantly, don't forget to sign and date your application.
- Next, you may have noticed that the application is divided into sections A, B, C and D. All applicants need to complete sections A, B, and C. If you are a high school student, your counselor must fill out section D.
- Did you pick a major (called a "program" in question 27)? The two-year degrees we offer are listed on the back.

Applicants must have an official high school transcript sent to our Admissions Office. If you hold a GED, you must submit a copy of your equivalency scores.

If you have not taken the ACT test, you must take Genesee Community College's Accuplacer placement test, which is free of charge. The placement test can be taken at any campus location. GCC almost always uses the Accuplacer placement test, ACT, SAT, and Regents test scores for placement purposes.

What about financial aid?

Over 80% of students at Genesee receive some form of financial aid. In addition to federal and state aid, Genesee offers a wide variety of scholarships for students. Here are the three simple steps for applying for aid:

- File the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at www.fafsa.gov. The Genesee school code is **006782**.
- Apply for state aid NYS TAP (Tuition Assistance Program) by either using the link for state aid on the confirmation page of the FAFSA or by visiting www.hesc.ny.gov. The Genesee school code for TAP is **2252**. You can also apply for the **NYS Excelsior Scholarship** as well.
- Apply for Genesee Scholarships at www.genesee.edu/finaid.

How will I know what to do next?

With few exceptions, Genesee is an open-admission institution. We notify in writing all applicants who have been accepted. However, if your application is incomplete, we will communicate your status by phone, email or letter detailing any missing documentation.
