Checklist for Homeschool Enrollment (9 Steps)

1. Application: You must submit an application prior to placement testing and registration. [Homeschool Application \(PDF\)](#)

2. Password Setup: Create your MYGCC password.

3. Homeschool MOU & Proxy: Sign and submit the homeschool MOU and designate a proxy in your MYGCC account.

4. Testing: Contact the testing center to schedule your ATB (Ability to Benefit) placement test: placement@genesee.edu

5. Register for Classes: Meet with the homeschool specialist to review test results; using the list of approved courses, select courses from the GCC master schedule. Submit the homeschool registration form or register via MYGCC (by Aug 15 for fall; Jan 15 for spring). [GCC Master Schedule](#)

6. Certificate of Residence: Submit once each year or tuition will be charged at double rate. Instructions and affidavit: [Certificate of Residence](#)

7. Proof of Immunization: If you register for 6 or more in-person credits, submit proof of immunization: [Immunization Form \(PDF\)](#)

8. Books and Materials: Obtain books and materials before classes begin. The BookSmart fee covers most materials depending on the course: [BookSmart](#)

9. Success Course: Complete the Success Course in your MYGCC account.
